My hats name: Saturnalia Lady

Theme: I have chosen to look at Saturn as a rough guide for my shape, it is very classic shape and line for a classic hat. Saturnalia is the ancient Romans festival of Saturn in December and is a predecessor to Modern Christmas festivities.

Materials: My crown base will be made from felt, blocked on a normal crown base, the crown will be wired and cut on a diagonal, the brim will be made using wire and a gathered veiling, I have yet to 100% decide on my trimmings.

How it should be worn: I intend my design to effortlessly go with any of the three outfits provided but I would match it with the grey personally. The hat itself should be worn on a slant, with the left side being more raised than the right when looking at it on a dolly head (the right side should be raised if it is on your head). The centre back is marked by the join of the petersham inside and the wire join of the brim is also on the centre back.






Statements

What is the concept and inspiration behind your collection?

My collection is called Tribal Comforts and as the name suggests I was inspired by the tribal clothing of Africa, in particular the way the drape the materials over their body, along with the need for beautiful but comfortable clothing for women, many factors can affect a woman's waistline and it will vary throughout the day. My collection is designed to always be comfortable while always staying beautiful.

What does sustainable fashion mean to you and why do you want to be a sustainable fashion designer?

Sustainability for me is in value, if we truly valued our clothing it would inevitably be more sustainable. Sustainability for me is good working conditions and fair wages for all being reflected in purchasing prices, it is making people understand that if a t-shirt is a pound corners are being cut somewhere. I also believe we have an abundance of textiles already and virgin fibres are no longer necessary, it is more important to refine recycling techniques. I want to become a sustainable designer to make a great environmental and social impact.

How have you incorporated the 'Design for Low Waste' (zero-waste/up-cycling/reconstruction techniques) circular design strategy in your collection?

My designs have been based on upcycling household fabrics into beautiful and comfortable garments. I'm certain my designs could be continued to be worked with to eliminate waste however my textiles are large and more than one dress can be made from the fabrics. Any spare materials an be made into headscarves.

How have you incorporated the 'Design for Low-impact Materials and Processes' circular design strategy into your collection?

All of my designs are based on upcycling materials sourced from charity shops, eliminating the need for new materials, I think my designs are also very flexible and would work in various colours and patterns. Two out of three of my designs are made from 100% cotton making them biodegradable and easy to recycle, the other design is made from poly cotton making it more durable in the long run but still recyclable.

How have you incorporated 'Design for Longevity' in your collection design?

The QR code incorporated on my illustrations is what I would use as a label. Within this code I will tell a story of the garment including the time it took for someone to make the garment, where it was made, where the material was sourced, in the hope that it will make the garment more sentimental to the buyer. I would also only make a limited amount of the garments and thus increasing the value to the owner. I have also added information on how to care for the garments to the label in order to reduce things like shrinking and/or colour fading causing waste.

How have you incorporated the 'Design for Recyclability' circular design strategy into your collection?

Two out of three of my designs are made from 100% cotton meaning they are very easy to recycle, however in the UK almost all textiles are recycled and those that cannot be made into new textiles are added to mattress fillings. I have also added note to the label information that asks people to recycle or give the garment to charity when they no longer want it.

How could your designs be adapted and reproduced on a larger scale?

I believe my designs could easily be adapted for large scale manufacturing however it would be hard to source lots of the same fabric, however multiple garments made from different fabrics would only increase their value to the customer as they would be more unique.

Why did you apply for this competition and what are you most looking forward to?

I started looking at sustainability as part of a fashion film project at university. I became very interested in waste reduction and used your learning materials as part of my research. It then felt natural to me to continue and enter the competition. I am most looking forward to seeing how far I can go and gaining some feedback on my work from an industry perspective. 
Shush...

Shush... has been heavily influenced by taboo subjects, subjects people would rather not talk about. My main focus has been on hidden illnesses such as mental health disorders and pain disorders, both are things that heavily affect my daily life.

My dress pattern was inspired by the main pain points for a person with fibromyalgia, the concentric circles show that the pain disperses further than these points. The back and the front of the dress are also different, showing the two sides of mental health issues such as bipolar disorder, the front is very busy while the back of the dress is plain, showing that sometimes things can be ok. The silhouette of the dress has been inspired by a picture of a person crouched down holding their head in their hands, a common representation of a person dealing with mental health issues. The cage was influenced by imagery expressing mental health as being like a prison cell, this is often how I express how I feel, it is also how I feel about my physical health, my body is a prison, never being able to do what I want, when I want.


I decided to use greys and black in my design due to the fact that 90% of the imagery representing mental health disorders or feelings were black, dark, gloomy and grey, this can also often describe how living with depression can be, nothing is goo, everything is grey.
