

## **Negotiated: Vinyl Record Sleeve**

With a lot more creative freedom in this project I wanted to down a more music related route so I designed and created this gatefold vinyl sleeve for a fictional all female band known as the Sweethearts.





To make my sleeve more interactive I created a short graphic novel style story about the band arriving at a gig to perform. The band begin to play at the end of the story which leads to the start of the record for which I made the stickers in the centre of each side as seen above.







This is each side of the inner sleev which holds the record itself and slips into the poket of the outer gatefold sleeve. Featuring a tracklist in a screwed up note, this sleeve has been made to look as if all the items are on a table at the gig with polaroids of all the members, a can of beer and even the drummers sunglasses.



## **Self Promotion: Cassette Tape**



For the cover of the booklet included in the promotional item I incorporated the clear plastic case to add an extra layer of detail to the illustration as well as my initials and the year.










